Living with an excitable, active, or reactive dog? One who becomes over-excited when you get ready for a walk, whines in the car or while on walks, knocks visitors over in her enthusiasm, lunges or barks at other dogs while on a leash, becomes frantic when she sees other dogs at play, or barks at you for attention? This workshop is for you. Your dog can learn to be calm, controlled, and centred in the face of all things exciting, and I'll teach you how to get her there.

These workshops are suitable for dogs of all ages and abilities with a current vaccination. A questionnaire is located in the registration form to assist in determining the suitability of very reactive dogs – as stressed dogs are unable to learn.

To ensure individual attention, each workshop is limited to 8 dogs. Observer positions (without dogs) are also available.
